We were staffed at 742, we are close to 800 now. Last spring, we decided to use certain accounts to pay for additional teachers/classes. Brad assigned a teacher to one of those accounts. Last contact with Richard Holmes, HIS did not receive any more funding for us to pay teachers. If we receive funding, we will put that back into the Trustland account.

Plan

Trustland will pay approx \$60,000/year

Proposal States:

1.14 aide for Sped Life Skills

.6 of a teacher contract (approx \$45,000)

Brad will get financial numbers to council next week through email.

Biggest need (Mansell- New Science Teacher) - Chromebooks approx \$7000 per set

Community Council task is to find the greatest academic need to fill with Trustland Money.

Arthur: District should be paying for the growth, not Trustland.

Shirlayne: Grants are an option for chromebooks. Are we setting a precedence to the District that we will pay for teachers with Trustland money?

Brad: Data we use to identify and evaluate is called our Consolidated School Improvement Plan. Each department will be working on GVC (Guaranteed Viable Curriculum). We assess how many kids are lacking a skill, then we use interventions (such as Homeroom iZap), then evaluate how many kids are proficient after interventions. We only have 5% kids not proficient after interventions.

Arthur suggests compiling more data to identify greatest or additional academic need.
