Welcome:

Walked down to look at the new Wellness/Learning center

Brad: Csip data in and shows we have done well over 3,000 interventions and are seeing a 10.4% growth in efficiency.

As of today, we have had 284 visits to Learning Center for academics.

14 students are enrolled during a class period each day for extra help.

These students have the highest risk factor, needing both academic and emotional support. It is not the kids choice weather they get to go to the learning center. Communication between adults that asses that need for the student.

Many students missing daily bell work and reading logs which really affect their grade. (Many factors we will discuss with teachers)

We have had admin take about 6 or 8 kids down to just take a breather, calm down.... Not an in school suspension situation, but just someone upset and needs a few minutes in a calmer environment that is not the front office....

As we work out the communication we can take more on...

<u>Trustland money spent so far this year and projected cost for remainder of year:</u> Technology spent \$25,000 on Chromebooks, and we have enough combined this year to get another 3 sets of Chromebooks.. Chromebook needs- see chart with ranks ... We will spend them on those teachers who are at a ranking of 3-5 meaning old, slow, and can't test...

2019-2020 budget should be around \$90,000 plus some 6,000 ish that will roll over from this year. Because trustland growth is so new, we may even get another large sum to use for something like a licensed clinical social worker that does real therapy with kids, parents, and groups. They would be here only about 2 days a week.....there are some issues with combining monies that we need to check out....

2019-20 Goals:

Goals 1 - Instructional aid/ paras estimate \$33,665 could possibly add reading or ESL full time specialist

Goal 2 - Chromebooks if teacher need reaches a level 3-5 (\$8,000 per set)

Goal 3 - Co-teaching to lower class size (\$ 8,000 per 7th - \$ 11,200 per 5th)

Goal 4 - Counselor/ LCSW half day so we can have two full time counselors. \$24,00 ish Goal 5 - Bi-Tapps (\$150.00 pair)

Goal 6 - Reading tracking aid,. Someone students could give oral report to so there is more accountability for reading.

Rainy: Question, is anything done on reporting for fine arts classes, and those not tested like core classes? Yes, they have CSIPs and other online programs that evaluate music kids... Do they have programs like duolingo for English like they do Spanish and Chinese?

As of 3/27/19 we have served a total of 284 visits to the Learning Center for academics. Students work on missing assignments during this time.

14 students are enrolled during a class period each day to help them.

These students are at the highest risk factor for needing both academic help and emotional support.

43 7th grade students are on the list to be called in as well as 26 6th grade students.

The list of students being called in are from the High Risk assessment list generated by Powerschool.

Current average for Math is 64.08, up from 56.98 from 2nd trimester.

Science average currently is down slightly from 71.5 to 71.03 from 2nd trimester.

Language Arts is down 49.59 from 56.78 in 2nd trimester.

Many of our students are missing daily bell work and reading logs which really affects their grade.

Also the are writing argumentative essays which have proven to be quite hard for them.

Our Wellness Center has not fully opened up to the school yet.

There have been approximately 15 visits to the wellness side of our room so far.
