## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Can I pay for lunch over the phone?

No, however, you can pay online by going to paypumscom

Lunch is \$2.50 per day

#### Can I pay for school fees, supplies, etc over the phone?

No, we can't accept cards over the phone, however we accept cash, checks or cards in the office.

## Is Friday an early out day?

No, the only early out days we have are for monthly PLC teacher meetings and on those days we are out at 11:45am

### Can I ride a different bus home today?

No, the buses are overcrowded and only students that are assigned to ride may ride. District policy will allow for exceptions in certain circumstances, these need to be approved by the transportation department. The Space Available Form would need to be completed and sent to their office.

### Can I wear this outfit to school?

## Free and Reduced Lunch

Anyone that has not yet, but would like to apply for free/reduced meals, please go to <u>https://www.washkl2org/food\_service/free\_and\_reduced\_and\_apply\_online</u>. If your student was on free/reduced meals last year, you **WILL** need to fill out a new application. You have 30 days to re-apply, after which your student will be charged as a full pay student. It can take up to 10 days to process the application, so please do so as soon as possible. If you filled out a blue form at registration, this is NOT the form for free/reduced meals.





## Parent and Student PowerSchool Unified Classroom Account Setup Process

Parents: If you have never logged into PowerSchool, you will need to create a PowerSchool Account before proceeding. You can get that information from your school.

Parents: If you have already created a PowerSchool Account, you still need to create a new PowerSchool Unified Classroom username and password.

## To create a Unified Classroom Account:

- Parents and Students start at <u>http://www.washk12.org/powerschool</u>.
- Click on the "Click here to register for a Unified Classroom account" link.
- Select "Parent" or "Student" from the menu (white page).
- The Unified Classroom Account page will open in a new tab (blue page).
- Select the "Create PowerSchool ID" button.
  - Note: You may need to scroll down to see the button.
- Enter your current username and password (white page).
  - Note: This is the username and password you already have.
- Click on the "Continue" button (blue page).
- Enter a PowerSchool ID and enter your password twice (blue page).
  - o Note: This can be the same ID and password as your current ID and password.
- Click the "Create PowerSchool ID" button (blue page).
  - Note: Make sure to take note of your PowerSchool ID on the screen.
- Click the "Continue to Unified Classroom Sign In" button (blue page).
- You can now sign in with your new ID.

## **Please note:**

- You will now always sign in to PowerSchool using the new user ID and password.
- From now on, you will always sign in at classroom powerschool.com
