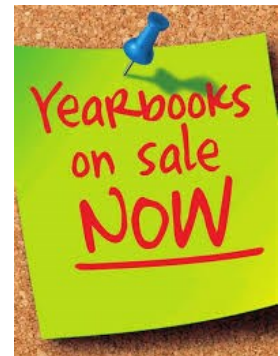

Rhonda is our new secretary. She also worked at HMS and HIS in the past for a short time.

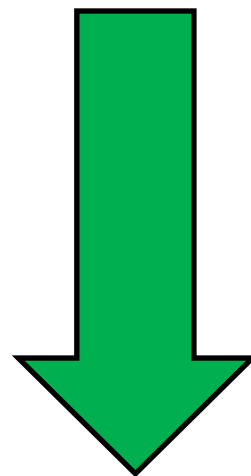

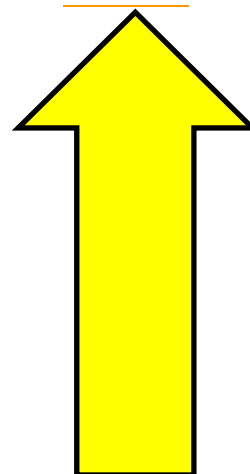
