As you look at grades in Powerschool this semester, you will notice that teachers are using only 3 categories to report student work (scores for individual assignments can be accessed by clicking on the blue letter grade and percent by each class). We are doing this to report accurately to you what is happening in school. Here are the categories:

Academic: These scores reflect what a student can demonstrate that he or she has learned. They will include tests, quizzes, and assignments that reflect individual student learning.

Effort: These assignments can be done as a class, group, individually, or with teacher or parent help. They are often practice activities.

<u>Citizenship:</u> These scores report how a student is behaving in class. They include getting to class on time, working on and completing assignments, not disrupting class, and treating others with respect.

We are proud of the hard work of our students and look forward to a fantastic new year.
