The Beauty of Fall

Are you enjoying the cooler breezes as you open your windows in the evening? We know change is coming, so we embrace its beauty for all the world to see. This is a time of year when the leaves begin to show new colors and neighbors emerge from their homes after months of heat. It is family portrait time and the whole world seems to take a second glance to admire our new look.

Our school has experienced our own season of change. We have a new principal, Mrs. Terri Howell, along with several new teachers. The intermediate level offers a stark change from past elementary school patterns and movement. Students are asked to make the necessary changes to adapt to the world where they are given more choice.

Here are four steps which will help our students sink roots into the fertile soil of learning:

- **1. Set the stage for learning.** Pick a comfortable and quiet location for studying. Make sure you remain nearby so that you can give encouragement as your student works.
- **2. Pay attention to timing**. Some students perform best right after school when their memories of instruction are fresh while others have a need to decompress after school with exercise or talking to a parent about their school day.
- **3. Plan ahead.** Be aware of the calendaring for each class and pay attention when large projects, reports, or tests are due. Success comes from systematic planning.
- **4. Practice.** Confidence can be built by taking practice tests while relieving anxiety. Review the material with your student and share your experiences learning in the home
