Welcome

We're eager to share an important tool available to you, your family, and your student(s). Your student's school is enrolled in SafeUT—a confidential app that offers 24/7 access to support from licensed mental health counselors at no cost to you. There is also the ability to submit tips for safety and mental health concerns to prevent violence and suicide in Utah.



SafeUT supports parents and guardians by providing:

- access to mental health support and services from master's level counselors at no cost any time for your student
- access to mental health support and services to parents and guardians, to discuss challenges and stresses you, your student(s), or another person may be having
- a safe, back-up place for your student to turn to if they are searching for advice from a
 trusted adult such as when you are working, if you are sleeping, or when they or a friend is
 in trouble and they don't know how to ask for help
- a way for you or your student to confidentially report bullying, fights, threats, self-harm, or other safety concerns to the school

SafeUT is a state-funded service, provided by the Huntsman Mental Health Institute's Crisis Services Department, that works in partnership with Utah schools to increase student safety. Our counselors are here to help with any size concern whether it's related to school, work, or home.


You can download the SafeUT app from the Apple or Google Play app stores or visit SafeUT.org to learn more. Once you've installed the app and set a password to keep your interactions confidential, you'll be able to chat with a master's level counselor, directly call a certified crisis worker, or submit confidential tips to crisis counselors and school administrators 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Students will receive training on how to use the app at school.
