<p><b><u>Topic 1:</u></b> Discussed <b>H Town 3</b> (Responsibility, Resilience, Respect And <b>Collective Commitments</b> (Enforce Learning, Build a Culture of Collaboration, Do What's Best for Kids) We have put posters of both of these in each classroom and around the school. -</p>
<p><b><u>Topic 2 :</u></b> <b>School Improvement-</b> After testing we will want to see at least a two point improvement over last year's score of 76. Documented improvement would be a score of 78 but we are hoping for much more.</p>
<p><b><u>Topic 3:</u></b> <b>Next year</b> we will use Trustland and TSSA money to pay for: Coding teacher - Paras - Wellness Center aid - Computer lab aid - technology (Updated Chromebooks that will support next years testing) - PBIS Store (student behavior support) -</p>
<p><b><u>Topic 4:</u></b> Discussion regarding Wellness room:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Data shows that Tuesdays and Thursdays are the high volume days. 614 students were assessed in the first semester, 558 during the second semester.</li><li>• Data shows a lower number of 6th graders at the first of the year. The 6th grade visits increase during the second semester once they are aware we have a wellness center .</li><li>• Data shows even female to male ratio. Last year more females utilized the wellness room.</li><li>• Data shows behavior spikes between 9:00 -10:00 AM , then again between 1:00 -2:00 PM. This lines up with both 1st and 2nd semesters.</li></ul>

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**Topic 5:**

PBIS - Jag Bucks student behavior rewards system:

- Data shows that males are rewarded more frequently than females. We will discuss this with the faculty and see if we can determine why this is happening.
- Data shows about equal amounts of 6th and 7th graders being rewarded.

**Topic 6:**

Safety in Parking lot:

- We have put up several cones to direct the parent drop off traffic and keep it confined to the drop off zone and away from the actual parking lot. This seems to be helping to keep students safe as they park their bikes and make their way to the school building..
