

February's Message From Mr. Eves

As we begin this new term, I want to take a moment to emphasize the vital role families play in fostering both academic and personal success for our students. The Power of Connection

When students feel supported both at school and at home, they are more likely to engage, persevere, and succeed. Simple, consistent efforts to connect with your child about their day, their goals, and their challenges can make a significant difference.

Here are a few ways to strengthen those connections:

- 1. Ask About Their Day: Go beyond "How was school?" and ask specific questions like, "What was something interesting you learned today?" or "What made you laugh?"
- Encourage Responsibility: Support the principles of our school motto, the H-Town 3—Respect, Responsibility, and Resilience—by helping your child stay organized with their assignments and prioritize their time.

Get your immunizations Early! Important Immunization Information!





All upcoming 7th grade students need the following additional immunizations BEFORE the start of the school year:

1 Meningococcal

- 1 Tdap booster (Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis)
- 2 Hepatitis A and 3 Hepatitis B Immunizations

2 Varicella (Chicken Pox) Immunization (or proof of having had the disease by signing the official card.

If your student has received these immunizations, please provide a copy of the immunization record to the school before school starts. If you have previously submitted an exemption form, please note that Section 53G-9-303 of the Utah Statutory Code requires these exemptions to be renewed before 7th grade entry. This needs to be done on a computer not a mobile phone as the Certificate does not download correctly. You will need to send in a copy of the New Exemption Certificate. Remember that all of the Vaccine boxes need to be checked off. Please check that before printing it. For any questions, feel free to email me @cheree.crosby@washk12.org.




Mt. Readmore-Principal's Pick


