



HIS Policy: Electronic Devices (Phones, iPods, etc.)

Students are allowed to use electronic devices (phones, iPods, AirPods, game devices, etc.) **before school begins** each morning until the bell rings to send students to class. Once that occurs, students are expected to power off their devices and **place them in their backpacks** where they will remain until the end of the day—this includes listening devices as well.



Students who ignore this policy may be asked to hand over their device to a faculty member where it may be taken to the main office. In those instances, parents will be contacted so that they can come to the school at their earliest convenience to pick up the device.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COINS FOR KIDS CHRISTMAS ASSISTANCE

1. KONY Coins for Kids (CFK) is a 501(c)(3) charity that raises money to provide

Christmas gifts for children in need in our community.

- 2. Families must get a referral letter from their child's school with each of the children, aged birth through 17 years old, listed on the letter. A separate referral from each school is not needed.
- E CONTROL MANAGEMENT OF THE SECOND OF THE SE
- 3. Families are only eligible for Christmas assistance from Coins for Kids for up to *THREE* times in a 10-year period. If a family has already received assistance three times from Coins for Kids, they can apply for Christmas toys through Toys for Tots at toysfortots.org. Families that need assistance should apply EITHER through Coins for Kids OR Toys for Tots, NOT both. Completing the application process with BOTH organizations will disqualify the applicant from receiving assistance from either organization. Coins for Kids and Toys for Tots work together to ensure there is not duplication in requested assistance.
- **4.** Parents need to APPLY ONLINE at https://coinsforkids.net/ for assistance between Oct. 16 and Nov. 15, 2025. Online applications after Nov. 15 will not be accepted.
- 5. Applications will be reviewed to ensure they have not exceeded the three times in a ten-year period requirement. If not approved, the applicant will be contacted and referred to Toys for Tots Christmas assistance.
- 6. After applying online, applicants **MUST COME** to the Verification Center with the required documents to complete the application process. The Verification Center will be located at the Washington County School District Office Building at 121 W. Tabernacle, and will be open the week BEFORE Thanksgiving
 - Tuesday, Nov 18 from 1 pm 7 pm
 - Wednesday, Nov 19 from 8 am 5 pm
 - Thursday, Nov 20 from 8 am − 5 pm
- 7. The applicant must bring the following to the Verification Centerinterview:
 - 1. <u>PhotoID and proof of residency in WashingtonCounty</u> (If the ID doesnot show their current address, proof of residency such as a Utility Bill or Insurance, Credit Card, or Bank Statement)
 - 2. Children's Birth Certificates of EACH child showing linkage to parents
 - 3. OR Court Documents if child is in the custody of someone other than a parent
 - 4. Referral Letter from school counselor
- 8. Children are NOT allowed at the Verification Center. The only exception is a child in an infant carrier. If the applicant needs childcare assistance, please call the Family Support Center at 435-674-5133 regarding their no cost service.
- 9. Applicants should not come to the Verification Center if they are sick.
- 10. Once a family is approved, they will either be adopted by a family or organization in the community, or they will have KONY Coins for Kids volunteers shop for their family, wrap the gifts, and then deliver them on WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 17 BETWEEN 4-9 pm.
