# Jag Time: Supporting Every Student

Jag Time is a dedicated part of our school day designed to provide students with both academic support and meaningful enrichment opportunities. This time allows us to be intentional about meeting student needs while keeping core instruction focused and effective.

During Jag Time, teachers can provide targeted **intervention**, allow students to **make up missing work or assessments**, and offer a variety of **enrichment and activity-based opportunities**. On designated **priority days**, teachers may send students to specific activities that support school programs, skill development, or positive engagement.

In addition, teachers are able to **pull in students who need extra help**, reteaching, or additional time with content. This structure ensures students receive personalized support without interrupting whole-class instruction during regular class periods.

Jag Time allows our staff to:

- Provide individualized academic support

- Address learning gaps and missed work

- Offer enrichment and activity-based opportunities

- Personalize instruction based on student needs

Our goal with Jag Time is to ensure every student has access to the support, guidance, and opportunities they need to be successful—academically and beyond. This intentional time helps us respond proactively to student needs and reinforces our commitment to helping all Jaguars grow and succeed.





# SCHOOL FEES AND FINES/ PARENT POWERSCHOOL



**If you need to create a Parent PowerSchool Account**  
**Please call the school for your Parent PowerSchool Access Letter.**

## ***How do I pay open fines for my child?***

In the Parent PowerSchool account, click the "Your Family" button. Select a student from your list. On the right of the page, select "View Open Fines" from the list of links. Click the checkboxes of the fines you'd like to pay, and click the "Pay Selected Fines" button. The fines you have chosen will be added to your shopping cart.

## ***How can I change my user name, password, or contact information?***

Click the "Your Account" text link at the very top of every page. This will take you to a form which is filled in with the information you submitted when you signed up (or from the information received from the School District website). Change any information and click the "Update Account Information" button.

## ***How can I purchase items which are available to my students?***

Click the "Your Family" button. Select a student from your list. On the right of the page, select "Products available to Your Student" from the lists of links. This will take you to a page displaying only products available to the selected student.

## ***How to Add a student to a Parent PowerSchool Account***

In Parent PowerSchool account you should see the Account Preferences on the left menu. Click on the Students tab, then click on the Add+ button and enter your student's Access ID and Password. (If you do not have these codes please call the school to get them.) Add that information and submit!
